

Kernow came second . . .

The Kernow run of wins in the annual tournament against Devon came to an abrupt end with the Cornwall squad going down by 22- 14 points to the neighbours across the Tamar.



The match was played at the recently opened terrain at the Royal North Devon Golf Club, Westward Ho!, on a mainly overcast and dull day with a couple of wet spells during the afternoon. Second Cornwall team was Kernow 1 – Andy Rose, Tim Austin and Pete English – who ended on three wins.

Three of the Cornwall losses during the day were narrow: two to 12 and another to 11, so the overall result could have been closer.
